ARTS

- Elizabeth D. (Simmonds) Godin Scholarship:** for a student(s) in the Music Program: preference given first to a student from Charlottetown area, then open to all Music students from Prince Edward Island
- Prince Edward Island Law Society/Law Foundation Award:** for a returning PEI student who has completed Political Science 2110, 4010 or Business Law 3010 and is currently enrolled in or has completed Political Science 2120, 4020 or Business Law 3020, based on academic achievement
- Theresa (Zaat) Maloney Memorial Bursary:** for a Music student on the basis of musical merit who has a positive attitude and financial need

NURSING

- ❑ **Alumnae Association of the PEI Hospital School of Nursing (Winter Award):** for a fourth year nursing student at UPEI who has a demonstrated financial need and is not already receiving any other major donor funded award
- ❑ **C. Jean (Ross) MacKay, RN Nursing Scholarships:** for returning nursing students who intend to pursue an international experience as part of their UPEI education; preference given to students who display attributes of future professionalism such as integrity, stability, empathy and commitment
- ❑ **Heather L. Howatt, RN Memorial Awards for International Placements:** for two undergraduate nursing students in good academic standing and have been selected to participate in an international placement
- ❑ **Margaret Herring Memorial Nursing Award:** for a third or fourth year student who is a resident of Prince Edward Island, excels academically and clinically and is enrolled full time in the BSc Nursing Program

SCIENCE

- ❑ **Wayne Cutcliffe Computer Science Co-op Education Award:** for a computer science student who has completed two work terms in the Co-operative Education Program and intends to return to the UPEI Computer Science program in the next academic year; successful recipient will demonstrate commitment to the program and have a minimum 75% average in the preceding academic year

INTERNATIONAL

- ❑ **Dr. Vianne Timmons International Student Award:** for a second year full time undergraduate International student in good academic standing who demonstrates involvement, both on and off campus
- ❑ **International Scholastic Achievement Prizes:** for international students who maintain a minimum average of 75% and have contributed to the campus community, and have not previously received this prize
- ❑ **Ambrose Lee International Student Prize:** for an international student (not including US students) who has used the services of the Webster Centre for Teaching and Learning.
- ❑ **UPEI Student Adversity Award:** for a current international student who has experienced unexpected hardship in the past year, which has greatly impacted their personal circumstances and capacity to continue their studies. Examples of unexpected hardship may be due to economic, financial, political, societal, family or personal events beyond the student's control. Preference will be given to international students pursuing full time studies.

SINGLE PARENT/MATURE STUDENT/ACCESSIBILITY

- ❑ **Gerald Auld Memorial Bursary:** for a full-time single parent student in good academic standing and need
- ❑ **Marion Gillan Memorial Education Bursary:** for a single parent student in good academic standing and financial need; preference for a student in the Education program
- ❑ **Notre Dame Academy Alumnae Bursary:** for a full-time single parent student with children living at home
- ❑ **UPEI Memorial Bursary for Accessibility Services:** for a student registered with Accessibility Services, based on financial need
- ❑ **My Abilities Award:** for a full-time student registered with Accessibility Services at UPEI who has demonstrated involvement in community and/or campus life. In the event of two or more equally qualified candidates, preference will be given based on financial need.

FINANCIAL NEED

- ❑ **Hamed Shaker Nasry and Mabrouka Memorial Scholarship:** for a student pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree, is normally residence in Canada, completed their previous ten years of study in a Canadian educational facility, and who is in the greatest financial need.
- ❑ **Harold B. Schurman Bursaries:** for PEI students who graduated from a PEI high school based on financial need and academic accomplishment
- ❑ **Kay (Kelly) Rowe Memorial Award:** for a returning student in financial need who is the child of a single parent
- ❑ **MacAskill Bursaries:** for two deserving full-time students of good academic standing based on financial need
- ❑ **Making It Possible Bursaries:** for returning undergraduate students in greatest financial need
- ❑ **Melinda Stoodley and Andrea Gallant Award:** for a student who has a demonstrated financial need

- Strathgartney Scholarship:** for a deserving second year student based on academics and financial need
- UPEI Alumni Association Award:** for a full-time student who shows a demonstrated financial need
- UPEI Memorial Bursaries:** for undergraduate students at UPEI and AVC, based on financial need
- UPEI Merit Awards:** for full time students based on financial need
- UPEI Women's Group Bursaries:** for two students: one to a mature, female student experiencing financial need; and the second to a student in any faculty who is experiencing severe financial need
- Victor Lyall Goodwill Scholarship:** for a UPEI student based on financial need
- Thunder Cove Breast Cancer Community Spirit Award:** for an undergraduate student who submits the best essay on how breast cancer has touched their life, or the life of their family or friends, and who is in financial need.

- The Kiwanis Club of Charlottetown Award:** for a full-time Island student in good academic standing, with involvement in university or community service or other activities of a charitable nature which assist others in the learning or developmental process (ex. coaching, teaching, Student Union)
