DESCRIPTION

CRITERIA

The Lorne & Ruby Bonnell Scholarship will be granted annually to a student:

- Who is a graduate of a Prince Edward Island High School;
- Who is a graduate of University of Prince Edward Island, with high academic standing; and
- Who has been accepted into a graduate program in the sciences at a Canadian university

Preference will be given to students who have been accepted into a graduate program at the University of Prince Edward Island.

This donor funded scholarship would be in addition to any program, departmental, or stipend funding that the successful graduate student may already be receiving.
