

PEI ASSOCIATION FOR NEWCOMERS SCHOLARSHIP

DESCRIPTION

The PEI Association for Newcomers to Canada (PEIANC) has established the PEI Association for Newcomers Scholarship to assist first generation PEI newcomers who are in good academic standing and who contribute to the community. One scholarship valued at \$500 will be awarded per academic year.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Scholarship applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria to be considered for an award scholarship:

- Applicants must be current students at UPEI.
- Applicants must be first generation newcomers to PEI.
- Applicants must complete and submit the application and written personal statement. The personal statement (maximum 1 page) should address the applicant's experience as a newcomer to Canada, and their community involvement and future plans. Preference will be given to students who have not yet received this scholarship.

SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

The PEIANC Scholarship Selection Committee will consider the applicant's previous and current academic record and their community involvement. Applications are due by November 1.
