From “VK to C in 50” Scholarship

DESCRIPTION

“*From VK to C in 50*” scholarships have been established by an anonymous donor to mark his 50th anniversary in Canada. Arriving here as a refugee, he benefited from the education system in this country and went on to become a world-class nation builder in his professional life. Turning to philanthropy in his retirement, he is offering scholarships in every province and territory to mark this special occasion and to thank Canada for the opportunities it afforded him.

VK is Velke Kapusany, Slovakia, the donor’s birthplace, while **C** signifies Canada. The Ottawa Community Foundation is pleased to facilitate this act of generosity from coast to coast to coast.

CRITERIA

One renewable scholarship (\$2,000 X 4 years undergraduate degree) awarded to a student entering UPEI that meets the following criteria:

- Accepted as a full-time student entering their first year of study at UPEI;
- Has demonstrated financial need;
- Preference given to Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents of Canada
- Registered in an undergraduate program or pursuing an articulated program (College + University)

For renewal, students must maintain full-time studies in good academic standing, after each year of study (maximum of four years of funding). If for any reason the successful candidate should discontinue studies at UPEI, and therefore lose eligibility for renewal of this scholarship, another candidate - entering the same year of study that the original recipient would have been entering - will be chosen.

APPLICATION PROCESS (Deadline: March 1)
