# The ISAE 2018 Legacy Scholarship

### DESCRIPTION

The International Society for Applied Ethology (ISAE) held their annual international congress at UPEI in 2018. This scholarship is a legacy from the ISAE 2018 conference to enable students from UPEI to benefit from attending this international meeting and present their work on applied animal ethology and animal welfare.

## **CRITERIA & APPLICATION PROCESS (Deadline: March 15)**

The scholarship will be granted to a student currently registered at UPEI who has had an abstract for an oral or poster presentation accepted at that year's International Congress of the International Society for Applied Ethology. The scholarship is to support costs associated with attendance at the Congress to enable the student to present their work on applied animal ethology and animal welfare. It will not normally be awarded to the same student more than once. Applicants should apply to the AVC Graduate Studies and Research Administrative Office by *March 15th* of each year. The application must contain all of the following information:

- 1. Name of applicant
- 2. Postal and email address
- 3. Program, year of Study, Department
- 4. Title and half-page summary of their research program
- 5. Copy of abstract submitted to the ISAE Congress, including title and authors
- 6. One-page CV and a list of previous conference presentations and publications
- 7. Budget for conference attendance.

Notification of abstract acceptance must be provided to the AVC Graduate Studies and Research Administrative Office as soon as it has been received. Any graduate or undergraduate student registered as a full or part time student (at the time of application) in any program at UPEI is eligible. The award criteria will be in the following order of priority:

- 1. Abstract accepted (mandatory for consideration)
  - Oral presentation will be preferred over poster
- 2. Registered as a student at time of application (mandatory)
  - Preferred program of study is Applied Ethology or Animal Welfare, and background of the applicant in Ethology or Animal Welfare
