# Lévesque Graduate Fellowship in Human Health & Mental Health

# BACKGROUND

J.-Louis Lévesque graduated with a B.A. from Saint Dunstan's University (SDU) in 1934 and was granted an honorary doctor of laws degree by SDU in 1964. Through a generous endowment from the Fondation J.-Louis Lévesque, UPEI founded the Jeanne and J.-Louis Lévesque Fund for Nutrisciences and Health and has established the Lévesque Research Chair, the Lévesque Research Professorships, and the Lévesque Graduate Fellowships.

# CRITERIA

These fellowships will be granted to Graduate students (Master/Doctoral) currently registered at UPEI and engaged in the areas of human health, including mental health research. Applications will be assessed on the following:

- Academic standing
- Quality of the proposed research program
- Applicant's level of interest in future research
- Opportunity for the applicant to conduct meaningful research in a UPEI laboratory with a designated supervisor

Recipients may receive one Lévesque Fellowship in each of their Masters and PhD program(s), to a maximum of two fellowships per student.

# **APPLICATION PROCESS (Deadline: October 1)**

Application materials should be submitted to the Scholarships and Awards office at <u>scholarships@upei.ca</u>.
