



The McIntosh-MacLauchlan Writing Fellowships

DESCRIPTION

The McIntosh-MacLauchlan Writing Fellowship offers an exceptional opportunity to UPEI undergraduate students who have a gift for writing and a strong desire to spend the summer semester working as a writer. The recipients of the fellowships will have the equivalent of a summer job to create written works. Each fellow will have a UPEI mentor and access to shared office space on campus. The Fellowship is to be considered a full-time summer job and treated as such.

CRITERIA

Students applying for the McIntosh-MacLauchlan Writing Fellowship will be required to submit a 750-1000 word letter addressing why they are compelled to write and outlining what they would plan to do with this opportunity. Finalists will be required to participate in a live writing exercise for final selection. All undergraduate students are eligible to apply.

Applicants will be required to submit their writing for review at the end of the summer.
