ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

It is the student’s responsibility to refer to the University of Prince Edward Island Academic Calendar or upei.ca/scholarships to ensure he/she understands the eligibility criteria for specific awards and includes all the necessary documents (reference letters, essays, etc.) with the application form. **It is not necessary to include a UPEI transcript.**

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants must submit:

1. a “Scholarships, Bursaries, and Awards Application Form”;
2. a short essay explaining how the applicant meets the criteria of the bursary/scholarship being applied for and with a list of extra-curricular activities (i.e. volunteer work, sports, and part-time employment), course of study, and aspirations for the future; and
3. a “Financial Need Form” (if required in award criteria).

Please note that only completed applications will be considered.

Second Semester

GENERAL

- UPEI Alumni Bursaries**—Full-time students in any year may apply; based on financial need.
- Kiwanis Club of Charlottetown (Eugene “Toots” Richard) Memorial Bursary**—Open to a full-time student who participates in student activities and community service (provide written statement outlining this); include one character reference letter; based on financial need and academic accomplishment.
- MacAskill Bursary**—Based on financial need.
- Harold B. Schurman Bursaries**—Open to full-time students demonstrating financial need.
- UPEI Women’s Group Bursary**—One of these bursaries will be awarded to a mature female student who is experiencing financial need; the second bursary will be awarded to a student in any faculty who is experiencing severe financial need.
- UPEI Memorial Bursaries**—Full-time students in any year may apply; based on financial need.
- UPEI Merit Awards**—Full-time students in any year may apply; based on financial need.
- UPEI Memorial Bursaries (disabilities)**—Open to a full-time student with a disability; submit a letter describing your disability, along with a letter of recommendation from a doctor, counsellor, professor, staff from PEI Council of the Disabled, or any person in a position of authority other than family.

- Strathgartney Scholarship**—Awarded to a deserving second-year student; based on need and academics.
- Parkinson Society Maritime Region Scholarship**—Granted to a PEI student who submits the best personal essay on how Parkinson's Disease has directly affected his/her life or that of his/her family.
- The Kay (Kelly) Rowe Memorial Award**—Awarded annually to a returning full-time UPEI student who is the son or daughter of a single parent.
- Gerald Auld Memorial Bursary**—Awarded to a full-time student who is a single parent, has demonstrated financial need, and is in good academic standing.
- Andrea Gallant Award**—Awarded to a full-time student who has demonstrated financial need.
- Victor Lyall Goodwill Scholarship**—Awarded to a full-time student based on financial need.
- Melinda Stoodley Award**—Awarded to a full-time student based on financial need.
- Louis W. (Lou) MacEachern Award**—Awarded to a student who has been successful in his/her studies and has also been active in work/entrepreneurial activities, community service, or volunteerism and is in financial need.
- Matilda "Tildy" MacMillan Good Mentorship**—Open to a third- or fourth-year student who demonstrates a strong interest in historical/archival material and the creative/innovative use of technology in the storage/retrieval of such material.
- PEI Literacy Alliance bursary**—First-year student, who is a mature student and who has conquered literacy challenges in the past.
- The Russell and Florence Diamond Award**—Awarded to a second-, third-, or fourth-year, full-time student in good academic standing. Preference will be given to a student who is first in his/her family to attend university.

ARTS

- Theresa (Zaat) Maloney Memorial Bursary**—Open to music students.
- Elizabeth D. (Simmonds) Godin Scholarship**—Awarded to a full-time music student. Preference to students from the Charlottetown area.

BUSINESS

- The Senator Archibald H. Johnstone Scholarship**—Full-time student in the Bachelor of Tourism & Hospitality program who intends to pursue an entrepreneurial career on PEI and/or who will study abroad as part of his/her learning experience at UPEI.

NURSING

- PEI Hospital School of Nursing Award**—Awarded to a nursing student in his/her final year of study who is in financial need.
- The C. Jean (Ross) MacKay, RN Nursing Scholarship**—Awarded to returning nursing students who intend to pursue an international experience as part of their UPEI education.

SCIENCE

- PEI ACSW Engineering Bursary for Women**—Awarded to a female in the third year of the engineering program who demonstrates financial need and academic standing.
- John William Godin, P. Eng. Scholarship**—Awarded to a full-time student or students enrolled in the engineering program. Preference to students from the Charlottetown area.
- The DeLory Scholarship in Engineering**—Open to engineering students who are residents of Prince Edward Island.

OTHER (Note: The following bursaries/scholarships have specific eligibility requirements)

- Notre Dame Academic Alumnae Bursary**—Open to a full-time mature Island student who is a single parent; based on financial need and good academic standing.
- The Marion Gillan Memorial Bursary**—Open to a single-parent student, preferably in education.

- Laura M. Pickard Bursary**—Open to a full-time Island student who is a single parent with children living at home; based on financial need and good academic standing.
- Killam Properties Inc. Academic Achievement Awards**—Open to returning students who are tenants in good standing with Killam Properties, and have achieved 80 per cent or higher in the first semester.
- Royal Air Force Bursary**—Awarded to those connected with the regular or research air wing of the Canadian Armed Forces.
- The Donalda MacDonald CUPE Award**—Awarded to a female student who demonstrates a commitment to social justice issues and is in good academic standing.
- The MAPUS Awards**—Awarded to MAPUS members in financial need.
- Prince Edward Island Law Society/Law Foundation Award**—Awarded to a returning student who has completed Political Science 211, Political Science 401 or Business 301, and is enrolled in or has completed Political Science 212, Political Science 402 or Business 301 and is a PEI resident with scholastic achievement.
- The Henry S. Tam Scholarship for International Students**—Awarded to an international student entering his/her first year at UPEI in any faculty. Preference will be given to a student who is a resident of East Asia.
